Camping Frequently Asked Questions



Q: What tickets are available for trackside camping?

A: Unpowered Camp Site (2 people)

Q: Does camping include event entry?

A: 2 options are available as per above - with or without event access.

Q: What if I already purchased a General Admission ticket?

A: If you bought a General Admission ticket and later decided that you want to camp, you can simply purchase a campsite separately online at OUTIX. Additional people can be added to your site (up to 6 people per site max).

Q: Are children free?

A: Children aged 0 – 3 are free to camp. Children aged 4 – 15 years require a \$50 camping pass. Children 16 and up are required to hold an adult camping pass at \$120 (plus an event entry ticket).

Q: When does the campground open and close?

A: Trackside camping will open at 10am, Thursday 17th and close at 9am, Monday 21st August. Please note that times are subject to change and updates will be provided closer to the event.

Q: Is this per night?

A: Camping is priced for the whole event – Thursday (17th), Friday (18th), Saturday (19th), Sunday (20th).

Q: How many people can share a site?

A: The limit is 6 people per site.

Q: Is there vehicle access?

A: Yes, vehicles can move in and out of the campgrounds at all times. However please refrain from moving your vehicle if possible. Only 1 vehicle is allowed per Camp Site. An extra vehicle can be added by special arrangement. Please email us at camping@thebend.com.au to arrange.

Q: How big are the sites?

A: Each site is roughly 6m x 12m

Q: Can I choose my site?

A: Yes. However previous campers will be given preference to secure their site. Then all remaining sites will go on sale for general public.

Q: How close to the track are the sites?

A: The track is visible from some sections of the grounds, however key viewing areas are within walking distance of the campgrounds.

Q: Are powered sites available?

A: Trackside powered sites are not available. A number of powered sites are available at the BIG4 The Bend Holiday Park – contact them via <u>big4@thebend.com.au</u> to book.

Q: Can I bring a generator?

A: Yes, however to be considerate to other campers, generators are not to be used between 10:00pm and 7:00am.

Q: Are there restrictions to what type or size of tent?

A: Properly secured camping tents are acceptable. Marquee structures are not permitted.

Q: Can I sleep in my car?

A: Yes.

Q: Can I park my car on my site?

A: Yes, but only 1 vehicle per Camp Site.

Q: Can camping be purchased at the event?

A: No, camping must be pre-purchased.

Q: How can my friends of family camp on my site?

A: Camp Site can have up to 6 people. You can add extra people to your site at time of purchase via OUTIX website.

Q: What facilities will be available?

A: Toilet and shower facilities will be available within the campgrounds.

Q: Can we bring a BBQ into the campground?

A: Yes as long as it is structured (ie. no open gas burners/flames).

Q: Will there be ice available?

A: Ice will be available at the OTR located at The Bend Motorsport Park entrance.

Q: Can we have a camp fire on our site?

A: Only structured fire buckets are permitted, no fire pits or bowls. See diagram as a guide;



Timber will be available to purchase from the OTR located at the entrance to The Bend Motorsport Park.

Q: Can I bring my own alcohol?

A: Our Liquor Licence does not permit BYO alcohol, however you can purchase alcohol from within the event and bring that to your camp site. Absolutely no glass is to be brought into the venue.
