

Camping Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What is the cost for a camping package?

A: A weekend camp site at the Shannons Nationals is \$50 per person.

Q: When will I receive your camping pass?

A: You will be able to collect your camping pass from the time the campground opens.

Q: Does camping include event entry?

A: No, campers must also hold a general admission or grandstand ticket for event entry. To access the campgrounds you will require;

1. Campground pass/wristband
2. General admission or grandstand ticket

Q: Is this per site or per person?

A: Per person.

Q: Is this per night?

A: Camping tickets are priced for the whole weekend – Thursday (12th), Friday (13th), Saturday (14th) and Sunday (15th).

Q: How many people can share a site?

A: The limit is 6 people per site.

Q: Is there vehicle access?

A: Yes, however standard sites are restricted to one vehicle per site. Once your vehicle is on site it cannot leave until the end of the event; Sunday at 5pm.

Q: How big are the sites?

A: Each site is 6m x 10m

Q: Can I choose my site?

A: No, sites will be allocated.

Q: How close to the track are the sites?

A: The campgrounds are close to the Turn 1 viewing mound and grandstand. The racing circuit is not visible from the campgrounds.

Q: Are powered sites available?

A: No. Future events will feature powered sites.

Q: Can I bring a generator?

A: Yes, however in order to be considerate to other campers, generators are not to be used between 10:00pm and 7:00am.

Q: When does the campground open and close?

A: The campgrounds will open at 4pm Thursday the 12th of April and must be clear by 9am Monday the 16th.

Q: Are there restrictions to what type or size of tent?

A: Properly secured camping tents are acceptable. Marquee structures are not permitted.

Q: Is there an area for campervans, mobile homes, RVs and caravans?

A: Yes, such vehicles will have a dedicated camping area.

Q: Can I sleep in my car?

A: Yes, however standard sites are restricted to one vehicle per site. Once your vehicle is on site it cannot leave until the end of the event; Sunday at 5pm.

Q: Can I park my car on my site?

A: Yes, however standard sites are restricted to one vehicle per site. Once your vehicle is on site it cannot leave until the end of the event; Sunday at 5pm.

Q: Can camping be purchased at the event?

A: No, camping must be pre-purchased.

Q: If booking as a group, can we book separately?

A: No. The site and individual tickets must be purchased in one transaction.

Q: What facilities will be available?

A: Toilet and shower facilities will be available within the campgrounds.

Q: Can we bring a BBQ into the campground?

A: Yes as long as it is structured (ie. no open gas burners/flames).

Q: Will there be ice available?

A: Ice will be available at the OTR located at The Bend Motorsport Park entrance.

Q: Can we have a camp fire on our site?

A: No.

Q: Can I bring my own alcohol?

A: Our liquor licence is still pending. We'll advise further information before the event.
