

Camping Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What is the cost for a camping package?

A: Pricing for a weekend trackside camp site at OTR SuperSprint are as follows;

- Minimum site charge of \$190 (includes camping passes for two people)
- \$95 for each additional person to maximum of 6
- \$100 to upgrade to a powered site

Q: When will bookings close?

A: Camping bookings will close on Monday August 20 if not sold out prior.

Q: When does the campground open and close?

A:

- Thursday 23rd: 12pm – 10pm
- Friday 24th: 7am – 10pm
- Saturday 25th: 7am – 10pm
- Sunday 26th: 7am – 10pm
- Monday 27th: Campground closes at 9am

Q: When will I receive your camping pass?

A: You will be able to collect your camping pass from the time the campground opens.

Q: Does camping include event entry?

A: No, campers must also hold a general admission or grandstand ticket for event entry. To access the trackside campgrounds you will require;

1. Campground pass/wristband
2. General admission or grandstand ticket

Q: Is this per night?

A: Camping tickets are priced for the whole event – Thursday (23rd), Friday (24th), Saturday (25th) and Sunday (26st).

Q: How many people can share a site?

A: The limit is 6 people per site.

Q: Is there vehicle access?

A: Yes, however standard sites are restricted to one vehicle per site. Vehicles can move in and out of the campgrounds outside of event times (event times are between 8am – 5pm).

Q: How big are the sites?

A: Each site is 6m x 10m

Q: Can I choose my site?

A: No, sites will be allocated upon arrival.

Q: How close to the track are the sites?

A: The track is visible from some sections of the grounds, however key viewing areas are within walking distance of the campgrounds.

Q: Are powered sites available?

A: Yes. You can upgrade to a powered site for an additional \$100.

Q: Can I bring a generator?

A: Yes, however in order to be considerate to other campers, generators are not to be used between 10:00pm and 7:00am.

Q: Are there restrictions to what type or size of tent?

A: Properly secured camping tents are acceptable. Marquee structures are not permitted.

Q: Is there an area for campervans, mobile homes, RVs and caravans?

A: Yes, such vehicles will have a dedicated camping area.

Q: Can I sleep in my car?

A: Yes, however standard sites are restricted to one vehicle per site.

Q: Can I park my car on my site?

A: Yes, however standard sites are restricted to one vehicle per site.

Q: Can camping be purchased at the event?

A: No, camping must be pre-purchased. Camping bookings will close on Monday August 20 if not sold out prior.

Q: If booking as a group, can we book separately?

A: Yes, please purchase an "Extra person camping" ticket. Sites are limited to a maximum of 6 people.

Q: What facilities will be available?

A: Toilet and shower facilities will be available within the campgrounds.

Q: Can we bring a BBQ into the campground?

A: Yes as long as it is structured (ie. no open gas burners/flames).

Q: Will there be ice available?

A: Ice will be available at the OTR located at The Bend Motorsport Park entrance.

Q: Are cabins available?

A: No. Cabins will be available later in 2018 as part of our complete caravan park.

Q: Can we have a camp fire on our site?

A: Only structured fire buckets are permitted, no fire pits or bowls. See below diagram as a guide;



Timber will be available to purchase from the OTR located at the entrance to The Bend Motorsport Park.

Q: Can I bring my own alcohol?

A: Our Liquor Licence does not permit BYO alcohol, however you can purchase alcohol from within the event and bring that to your camp site.
